

Primary School Dress Standards

All students are expected to maintain the School's dress standards. To respect and support a positive teaching and learning environment, no aspect of a student's appearance should call excessive attention to him/herself.

All Students

Sandals, slides or Crocs are not safe and are inappropriate for active play.

Early School & Kindergarten

Students should wear clothing that is clean, appropriate to the school setting, and allows for freedom of movement. Velcro gym shoes must be worn for PE and recess.

Grades 1-4

Girls: Navy blue or tan Bermuda (long) shorts and uniform skorts are appropriate from the opening of the school year until cooler weather arrives (mid-October), and from April until the end of the academic year. Plaid uniform jumpers, khaki or navy polo dresses, and navy blue or tan slacks are appropriate year-round. The plaid jumpers may be found in Milwaukee at Goldfish School Uniforms, 414.476.4343, The Uniform Place, 414.258.7888, and from Land's End.

Boys: Navy blue or tan Bermuda (long) shorts are appropriate from the opening of the school year until cooler weather arrives (mid-October) and from April until the end of the academic year. Navy blue or tan slacks are appropriate year-round.

Girls & Boys: Shirts, sweaters, socks, tights, and leggings may be white, navy blue, light blue, or red. Shirts must be collared or turtleneck style. Plain red or navy sweatshirts, or those that have The Prairie School logo are appropriate. Other logos are inappropriate. NO jeans, denim pants, cargo, painter, carpenter or sweat pants.

Casual Dress Days

In Primary School, casual day happens every Friday unless otherwise noted. Neat and clean dress standards should be maintained. Neat and clean includes tasteful sweatshirts, blue jeans, warm-up suits, and shorts of an appropriate length, weather permitting.
