RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **ELIGIBILITY** - All players must be in good academic and disciplinary standing with his respective school policies during the season. This includes completing and forwarding to the respective Athletic Director any required forms and fees as designated by the player's school.
2. **CODE OF CONDUCT** - Per the WIAA, a student is required to follow the school's code of conduct on a year-round (12 month). All players are required to abide by mandated rules set by the WIAA (Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association), The Prairie School and Racine Lutheran High School, including and not limited to:
 - a. No player may consume alcohol
 - b. No player may possess, consume or sell any illegal narcotic /drug during the season,
 - c. No player may possess/consume any banned performance drug
 - d. No player shall commit any misdemeanor or felony violation of any Wisconsin Statute

Players violating the Code of Conduct" will face immediate disciplinary action as determined by the Coaching Staff, Athletic Directors and each school's Administration.
3. **ATTENDANCE** - Unexcused absence from practices and/or games is not tolerated. Three unexcused absences will result in disciplinary action in accordance with athletic policy. If a player does not attend school on the day of a practice/game, said player WILL NOT be allowed to participate in that day's practice/game. Tardiness for practice/game (excluding emergency situations) will not be tolerated.
4. **ATTIRE** - All players will wear prescribed clothing for all practices, as determined by the Coaching Staff, for both indoor and outdoor practices. Players SHALL NOT wear muddy or wet shoes into the indoor athletic facility at The Prairie School.
 - a. **GAME DAY ATTIRE:** Players will enter the Park of Play with caps on straight, jerseys tucked in, and uniforms that are cleaned for each game, including baseball spikes.
 - i. PLAYERS are RESPONSIBLE for CLEANING and MAINTAINING their assigned uniform (jersey, pants and belts).
 - ii. PLAYERS are RESPONSIBLE for RETURNING their assigned uniform items. Players are responsible for the total replacement cost of lost or unreturned uniform items.
5. **CANCELLATIONS** - Games and practices are subject to postponements due to weather, emergencies or unforeseeable circumstances. On school days, respective schools will notify athletes before the end of day. On non-school days, coaches notify players and families.
6. **COACHING STAFF** - Players and parents for both Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are given contact numbers for their respective coaches.
7. **PARTICIPATION/PLAYING TIME** - Practice and playing time are determined by the Coaching Staff. Time is based on observation, analysis, skill level, and "game situations." Playing time disputes WILL NOT be addressed during any game. Arrangements to meet with the Coaching Staff to address playing time or disputes can be made by a PLAYER.
