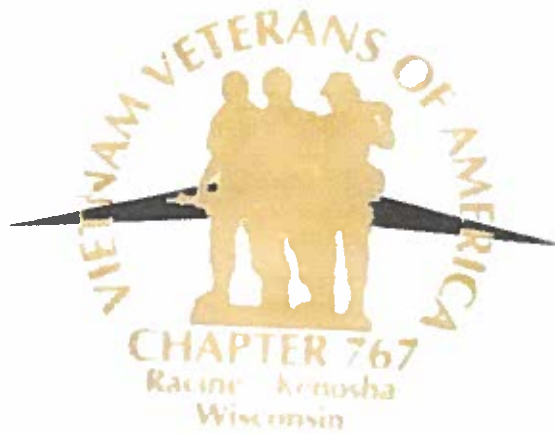

**\$1,000.00 Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 767 Scholarship**

**To: 2019 Racine /Kenosha High School Graduate**

**Subject: Scholarship for Post-Secondary Education**

**Dear Student:**

**Thank you for your interest in applying for The Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 767, 2019 Scholarship. To be eligible, you must be a High School Senior, a relative of a honorably discharged U.S. Military Veteran and a resident of Racine or Kenosha County, Wisconsin, unless you are related to a member of The Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 767.**

**The basic requirement for this scholarship, is to write an essay of from three to five pages based on an interview of an honorably discharged Vietnam Veteran relative or a member or non-member of The Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 767 who served on active duty any where in the world during the period February 28,1959 and May 7,1975. This Veteran's service must be verified by enclosing a copy of Form DD214. If needed, Chapter 767 will make available, a data base of qualified veterans who are willing to assist with interviews.**

The essay must be directly related to some aspect of the Vietnam War, must describe how the interview affected your perception of that War and what you learned from the interview of the Veteran. The interview may focus on the Veteran's military experience, perception of their military service, how their military service has effected their life or how the Vietnam War has affected the United States and /or the world. Your essay must include a bibliography with a minimum of two non-fiction sources from books or video tapes of which Chapter 767 maintains a library as an option.

The Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter 767, of Racine and Kenosha Counties, Wisconsin, hopes that you will gain a better understanding of those Veteran's experience's during the United States most controversial foreign conflict and through this scholarship, provide financial assistance in your pursuit of higher education.

## VVA 767 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- (1.) Applicant's relationship to a Vietnam Veteran shall be documented and verified by the Veteran's DD214 Form. (Contact the Racine or Kenosha County Veteran's Service Office for assistance)
- (2.) The Applicant must interview a Vietnam Veteran whose active duty must have taken place during the period February 28, 1959 and May 7, 1975.
- (3.) The essay must be original, typed, double spaced, three (3) to five (5) pages in length to include at least two bibliography resources.
- (4.) The essay, applicant's school transcripts and Veteran's DD214 Form must be mailed to the Vietnam Veterans Chapter 767 Scholarship Committee Chairperson by February 28th, 2019.

**NOTE: Entries that do not meet the above requirements will not be considered.**

What you learn from your research, how you express your ideas, your organization, essay appearance and use of grammar are of primary importance to the judging committee.

The recipient of the 2019 Scholarship will be notified prior to your high school's scholarship awards ceremonies and the \$1,000.00 scholarship check will be given to the recipient after successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary schooling.
