GOLF GUIDELINES

PRACTICE

We will practice every day during spring break. We would obviously love to be playing as many rounds as possible. The weather may have a different idea in mind. We will meet in the JAC unless the weather is very cooperative. If we are going to make changes in the schedule due to weather, We have each players cell phone # and will communicate by text. Each day we will be checking the weather forecast to predict the following day. If we are in the JAC, practice will last for around an hour and a half.

For both weeks Monday, Tuesday and Thursday will be at 3:00 and Wednesday and Friday will be at 11:00.

The rest of the season, we will practice every day after school. Some days we will be hitting balls on the range and/or working on our chipping and putting, while other days we will try to play nine holes. When the weather does not cooperate, we will meet in the JAC to work on our strength and flexibility. There are always days when this is a last minute call. We will encourage players to communicate with you regarding where we are practicing and what time practice will end.

ATTENDANCE

Players are expected to be at practice every day. If there is a circumstance (Dr. appointment, family emergency, etc.) where a player cannot make practice, the player must personally contact a coach ahead of time in order to be excused. Failure to communicate an absence will constitute an unexcused absence. The first unexcused absence will receive a warning and the second will result in elimination from the team.

EXPENSE

Players are expected to have their own clubs, balls and tees. The cost to play nine holes is between five and six dollars. The cost for a large bucket of balls is generally five dollars. Players need to have the money each day to cover these costs. The school will purchase some range balls from Johnson Park, but when they run out the players will need to purchase them personally.

DRESS CODE

During a match, players are expected to wear a collared shirt and slacks or similar shorts. Jeans are not permitted.

TRANSPORTATION

Suburbans will be used to transport players to and from practice. Players with their own cars may transport themselves to and from practice, but they may **not** give rides to other players. It is often more convenient for parents to pick players up from the golf course at the end of practice. There are times when the Suburban must return to school prior to the end of practice.

SCHEDULE

The schedule is posted on line. This includes early dismissal times, time of the match, and where the match is being held. If we have cancellations, we will try to update the schedule as soon as possible.
