Parents have the choice of (1) making a single annual tuition payment, (2) electing the semester payment schedule (\$90 finance charge payable in July; \$60 finance charge in January), or (3) contracting with our tuition management company, FACTS**, for a 10-month payment plan (\$40/month).

Tuition covers the major portion of instructional and academic costs, as well as instructional materials and routine diagnostic testing.

Inclusive Student Fee

This annual fee is paid in nine monthly installments, unless the family elects to pay the below amount in full.

The annual Inclusive Student Fee includes textbooks, field trips, classroom consumables, art fees, iPads, iPad insurance, apps, and other educational content for iPads, Primary School snack, Gr. 5-12 class trips/camps (Manito-wish, Washington D.C., Cincinnati/Indianapolis/Springfield/Hannibal, Timberlee), PSAT exam, graduation, Gr. 5-12 athletic uniforms and fees, Gr. 7-12 yearbook, Gr. 5-12 math/science/ROV/foreign language competitions, Gr. 7-12 Performing Arts scripts, scores, and dress/ tuxedo. Much like colleges and universities, these costs are billed separately, primarily for accounting purposes and because fees vary by grade.

Not included: lunch fees, specially arranged individual diagnostic or psychological testing, externally administered testing programs (SAT, ACT), ELL fees, speech therapy, AP exams, Stay & Play, Interim trips, Model UN, Kenosha and/or Franklin Bus, shoes for athletics or performing arts, personal or custom items, lost school-provided materials, per-payment tuition processing fee, etc.



Transportation

Prairie is pleased to offer private busing to our families residing in communities to the north and south of the school. For those living in Oak Creek, Franklin, and South Milwaukee, busing is available for an annual cost of \$500 per student (with a per-family cap of \$1,000). The northern route begins at HWY 100 and Drexel Avenue. For residents to the south, our Kenoshaarea bus begins at Highways 31 and 50 for the same annual cost. For families in Racine, busing is provided free of charge in conjunction with the Racine Unified School District (RUSD).
