

Spring 2020 End Of Year Calendar

All School

There will be no school on Friday, May 1st (a day of rest for everyone).

School will be in session on Friday, May 22nd.

A virtual version of Prairie Premiere will take place on Saturday, May 23rd.

There will be no school on Memorial Day (Monday, May 25th).

Each Division and the Athletic Department will be creating appointment calendars to pick up personal items that are still on campus in May.

Students in Grades 5-12 will receive information at the end of May outlining the procedure for returning their iPad or Chromebook (Grades 5 & 6).

Primary School

The last day of school for all PS students will be Friday, June 5th.

Grade 4 families will receive a celebratory video in early June and, if possible, an invitation to a Moving Up to Middle School party at the end of the summer before school starts.

Middle School

The last day of school for Grade 8 will be Wednesday, June 3rd.

The last day of school for Grades 5, 6, and 7 will be Friday, June 5th.



Grade 8 families will receive a celebratory video in late May and, if possible, an invitation to a Moving Up ceremony at some point before school starts — possibly on a Saturday morning in conjunction with Upper School Graduation weekend.

Upper School

For AP classes: the last day of class will be the day before the <u>exam date</u> <u>published by the College Board</u>. Students will be excused from all classes on days when they have an AP exam, even when that exam is in the afternoon.

The last day of school for Seniors will be Friday, May 15th (an F day). Seniors who are taking an AP exam are encouraged to attend that AP class until the day before the AP exam.

AP classes may give students timed practice exams and essays.

The last day of class for all non-AP and non-Malone Upper School classes for Grades 9, 10, and 11 will be Friday June 5th (an F day).

There will be no Interim program for Grade 11 students. They will continue to attend their classes to ensure that they are ready for their senior year.

There will be no traditional final exams in the Upper School this year. Faculty may assign comprehensive formative assessments depending on the needs of each course.

Senior Awards and their citations will be mailed to families and shared in the Graduation program. There will not be an awards ceremony for students to attend.
