We normally allow seniors the privilege of leaving campus during lunch if they choose to do so. Unfortunately, this year this privilege is no longer possible. Instead seniors will have the option to come to school late (second hour, if a student has commons first hour), and leave after their last class of the day. Students should only be missing commons periods. This privilege can be taken away at any time by the Upper School Head or Dean of Students if any issues occur. We understand that each senior is expected to:

1. Sign in and out for themselves by the Upper School office.
2. Be on time for your first class of the day. You need to be in the classroom (not just the building) on time. *If a student is late repeatedly, students risk permanent revocation of this privilege.*
3. Respect that this privilege is for seniors only. It is forbidden to take underclassmen off-campus and will result in loss of off-campus privileges.
4. Drive responsibly. Students must plan their time carefully. Your safety matters, and we expect you to show your maturity by not putting yourself in a position where reckless driving occurs.
5. Wear a mask when you enter the school building.
