## **COVID-19 Testing Hospital/Clinic Information**

Please Note: Call ahead to confirm. You typically can't walk-in and get tested. Most locations require an appointment and/or a doctor's order. Testing kits are limited in many areas.

### 1. Froedtert

- a. Screened over the phone first for risk factors and symptoms
- b. Upon screening, you will be asked to wear a mask and placed in an isolation room

- d. Averaging 48 hour turnarounds, but it could vary day to day. Oak Creek on Drexel is turning around in 24 hours.
- e. You need a virtual visit for an order, if you are not a current patient.

#### 2 Aurora

- a. Aurora Medical Center Aurora is offering drive-thru testing for community members who have at least one symptom of COVID-19. Advance registration is required online at <a href="mailto:aah.org/testing">aah.org/testing</a> or by phone at 877-819-5034. This service is available at Aurora's Kenosha and Burlington medical centers
- b. Locations Testing:
  - Aurora Medical Center Kenosha, 10400 75th St., Kenosha
  - Aurora Sinai Medical Center, 945 N. 12th St., Milwaukee
- c. If you are a patient, it could update as soon as 24 hours to your myChart, but if you are a drive-thru patient, it can be up to a week before receiving results.

## 3. Ascension

- a. Use our <u>COVID-19 self-assessment tool</u> as a first step to better understand possible symptoms. Take it online in just minutes or text COVID to 53901 for both English and Spanish.

- c. COVID-19 tests at Ascension facilities are only available following receipt of an order from a medical professional.
- d. At the drive-through testing site, patients will remain in their vehicle; accommodations will be made for individuals who don't have a car.
- e. Timeline--unknown
- f. Ascension Immediate Care on Spring Street averaging 1-2 days turnaround.
