

## COVID-19 Testing Hospital/Clinic Information

Please Note: Call your healthcare provider ahead to confirm. You typically can't walk-in and get tested. Most locations require an appointment and/or a doctor's order. Testing kits are limited in many areas.

1. Please call your physician if you would like to be tested by your healthcare provider.

Tuesdays & Wednesdays through December 8: **Central Racine County Health Dept.**, 10005 Northwestern Ave, Franksville, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Tuesdays through December 8: **Lakeland Community Church**, Lake Geneva, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Thursdays through December 10: **Festival Hall**, Racine, 9 a.m. -5 p.m.

Fridays through December: **Kenosha County Center**, 19600 75<sup>th</sup> St., Bristol, 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

4. **Walgreens** offers contactless, choice of rapid or PCR testing for **ages 3** and up. Go to Walgreens.com online to schedule an appointment near you. The closest testing sites to Racine are in Milwaukee: 620 W. Oklahoma Ave. and 4730 S. 27<sup>th</sup> St. – both in Milwaukee, approximately 30 minute drive.

**Rapid test resources: Best if used when you have COVID symptoms. If you do not have symptoms, the rapid test may give you a false negative result. PCR test is advised.**
