## COVID-19 Scenarios: A Quick Reference Guide

### Keep in Mind:

- The date of the last positive test in a household or the date of the last close contact is day zero.
- Even mild symptoms “count” and must be noted.
- All cases in a TPS household must be reported to the [School Nurse](#).
- No one may return to school on a Friday or the last day of school before a break.

<b>Your Family’s Situation:</b>	<b>Next Steps:</b>
I or my child have COVID symptoms.	Take a home or clinic test. Report any positive results in a TPS household to the <a href="#">School Nurse</a> .
I or my child tested negative for COVID but still have symptoms.	Your child should stay home until symptoms have improved. See Prairie’s Ill Child Policy, found at the <a href="#">bottom of this page</a> , for further guidelines, and test them before returning to school.
I or my child are unvaccinated and someone in our household has COVID.	Quarantine at home for five days from the date of the last positive test in your household. The positive test date is day zero. Your child may return to school on day six with a negative test.
My child is fully vaccinated (two shots) and someone in our household has COVID.	<u>Choose one of the following:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Quarantine for five days from the date of the last positive test in your household and return on day six. The positive test date is day zero.</li> <li>● Return to school by taking a home or clinic COVID test each morning for five consecutive calendar days.</li> </ul>
My child had close contact with a COVID-positive person who does not live in our household. They are fully vaccinated (two shots) and symptom-free.	Closely monitor for symptoms and continue to attend school. Prairie strongly recommends that you test your child each morning and that they mask at school for a minimum of five days.
My child tested positive for COVID. They have symptoms, even mild ones.	Regardless of vaccination status: isolate at home for seven days (test date is day zero) or until symptoms are resolved. Return on day eight or when symptoms are resolved.
My child tested positive for COVID. They are completely asymptomatic.	Regardless of vaccination status: isolate at home for five days (test date is day zero) and return on day six. Prairie strongly recommends masking at school for the first five days upon return.
